

Decorations, Vehicles, and Animals

- Living flowers or bulbs may be planted within one foot of the front of a raised monument or family marker. No plantings shall exceed the boundaries of the burial plot. The Trustees are not responsible for any flowers and may remove them if they are deemed unsightly.
- Natural flowers may be left at a grave site and shall be removed when dead or wilted. Artificial flowers are permitted and shall be removed by November 15th.
- No shrubs or trees shall be planted within in the cemeteries.
- One flag in good condition may be displayed at a grave site from May through November.
- The Trustees reserve the right to remove any items infringing on these regulations. Any exceptions to these regulations require permission of the Trustees.
- All vehicles in a cemetery must remain on established roads and are limited to 5 miles per hour.
- No animals are permitted in the cemeteries.
