Town Clerk Tax Collector The Town Clerk is responsible for vehicle registrations, dog licensures, elections, vital records, wetlands permits, telephone pole licenses and issues dump stickers. The Town Clerk is a Notary of the Public.

The Town offers On-line vehicle registrations; to access go to epsomnh.org. When you visit the office and want to renew your vehicle you must have your old registration. As of November 8, 2010, you need to only write one check for your registrations. Please make your check payable to the Town of Epsom. You can also pay by credit or debit card. Please note that Visa credit is not accepted for registrations. Visa debit can be accepted. A convenience fee of 2.85% is assessed to each credit card transaction. A flat fee of \$2.50 for each transaction of up to \$1,000 is assessed to each debit transaction. This fee goes to the vendor Vital Chek Network to cover their costs for this service. There is no charge to the Town of Epsom nor does the Town of Epsom receive any money for this service. First Issue Taxes are due Friday, July 1, 2011.
