The Old Meetinghouse Revitalization Committee meets to continue efforts to bring the Old Meetinghouse up to code for occupancy so it may be utilized as a community space. It is the goal of the committee to finance the effort through fundraising without utilizing taxpayer dollars.

- I. Approval of the September 14th meeting minutes** - George motion to accept the minutes. Norm seconded. September 14, 2022, meeting minutes approved as written.
- II. Septic and bathroom updates** – Virginia stated that septic system had received final approval. Construction has started on the retention pond area. Lower-level bathroom has been roughed in and new steel supports have been added to support the existing main floor.
- III. Old Town Hall Renovation project process updates** - Virginia - The new floor in the old Town Hall was in process and that new lighting was being added to meet lighting codes. Everything has been moved out of the building (the piano has been donated to someone). The Food Pantry may be able to move into the lower level of the OM in December if the current schedule holds. Kristy and Virginia – Will be working on an LCHIP grant to paint the OM and the remodeled Town Office exteriors.

IV. Other

Virginia - Asked everyone to consider fundraising opportunities. She will provide the Town Office with a display and Christmas Ornaments to sell. We should open the OM for tours when the Food Pantry has their open house. She will also update the FB page.

Chuck - Will develop a draft punch list of what we should complete to have a “working” main level that will also meet occupancy requirements. Will identify and purchase supplies/materials with remaining, budgeted Town funds.
