Old Business:

- 1) Potential Eagle Scout Project – *Approved and is in process did the first part of the Fence on July 17th*
 - a. *Bathroom toward the new fence next*
- 2) Selectmen's notes
 - a. Monitoring Flag for half-staff – Cheryl has volunteered to do the flags for the Town
 - b. Flowers for planting buckets- No new information
- 3) Dick Frambach looked at the nature trail needs to be mowed and lots of ticks and poison ivy. *Bartlett Tree sprayed around the park for poison Ivy. Ryan Burns weed wacked the trail.*
- 4) Proposal from A Huntley to do story walk along the trail. *No new information*

Status Report: *No more than 3-5 Min per topic*

- 1) Re-working the Horseshoe pits (EOHD use) *OHD Committee did a great job on the horseshoe pits they leveled the area and brought in fill. Almost complete*
- 2) spraying the poison ivy along the walking trail *Bartlett Tree sprayed around the park for poison Ivy. Ryan Burns weed wacked the trail.*
- 3) Playground review the broken equipment
 - a. Diggers are broken – Still not able to locate parts
 - b. See-Saw is broken – Gary is still working to fix the steel plate.

- c. Board of Selectman would like a monthly playground inspection. Nothing new to report
- 4) Fencing on the pond side of the basketball court/fencing post & rail style fence: 3 places which has priority? *Done by Gary and Boy Scouts, Next section to start this weekend*
- 5. Gate at Short Falls Swimming area will be done this year. *Nothing new to report*
- 6. Can bin located near Rte. 28 Odd Fellows organization monitors this (contact Gary Benner?). *The bin has been removed from Town Property located on the Fosters property*
- 7. Lighting at Pavilion should this be done---change to LED Gary working to change out. He will check with Until for rebates. *Nothing New to Report*
- 8. Wood chips for around the big pine tree roots & walking trail. *Will be complete the Thursday before OHD.*
 - a. *16 yards playground mix from K&K complete prior to OHD*
- 9. Push pine needles and soil over edge beyond the parking area near the garage. *Scott has pushed it all back*
- 10. Finish off the garage, possibly hire A.W Timber Works for the job (under \$5000.00 no bid needed-Verify) *Nothing new to report*
- 11. Go over park reservation requests Reviewed the calendar on the website. Still having issues getting information for car show *The Town will follow up on how to handle the reservation issue.*
 - a. *Recommend revising the application to include the year in the header*
- 12. Go over general town messages
- 13. Misc. Items
 - a. Signage to be placed by the dumpster- Town is looking into this (touch base with Andrea to check on wording potential to purchase at State Prison) Same for b & c. *Gary will work up language for the signs*
 - b. At Your Own Risk signs to be placed in various locations around the park
 - c. Town is looking in to “surveillance signage” in the park
