

PUBLIC NOTICE

EPSOM BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

The Epsom Board of Adjustment will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday December 2nd 2020** beginning at **7:00 PM** to take testimony on the following appeals.

Case 2020-06 (Burr Sign – Var) Amy Mejias & Drew Serbin, on behalf of Burr Signs, have applied for a Variance to Article III. Section M (Signs), Paragraph a, to allow for the installation of a third sign on the side of an Aroma Joe’s Coffee Shop. The sign ordinance permits only two signs per business. The property is located at the Epsom Traffic Circle within the Residential/Commercial Zone and is identified by Epsom Tax Map U-5 as Lot 52.

Case 2020-07 (M.Brown – Var) Mathew Brown has applied for a Variance to Article III. G. a (Single Family residential setbacks) to allow for a portion of an existing vehicle repair garage, and construction of a portion of a new addition to that garage, 5 feet into a 15’ side setback. The applicant is also seeking a Variance to Article II, Section C-10 (Automotive and Heavy Equipment Repair) to expand the size of a previously approved vehicle repair facility and business in the Light Commercial Zone. Such facilities are not permitted in this Zone, however, the existing business was approved by Variance in Case 2012-12 with conditions restricting the expansion. The property is located within the Residential/Commercial zone and is identified by Epsom Tax Map U-5 as Lot 52.

Public testimony will be considered in determining if sufficient evidence has been submitted to justify granting these zoning appeals.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, this public hearing will be conducted via zoom meeting.
