ARTICLE 1: Shall the Town raise and appropriate the sum of one million sixty-eight thousand eight hundred eighty-three dollars (\$1,068,883.00) to do site work and renovate the Meetinghouse into Town Office space, including but not limited to septic, water and parking, and authorize the issuance of not more than one million sixty-eight thousand eight hundred eighty-three dollars (\$1,068,883.00) of bonds or notes for that purpose in accordance with the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33), and to authorize the Selectmen to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon, and further to raise and appropriate the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) for the first year's interest payment? ARTICLE 1. Shall the Epsom School District vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$9,176,671? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$9,133,192 which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Epsom School District, or by law, or the governing body may hold one special meeting in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.

[Approval of the proposed School District budget will result in a projected \$.33 per \$1,000 increase in the tax rate. Rejection of the proposed budget will result in a projected \$.22 per \$1,000 increase in the tax rate.]
