ARTICLE 1: Shall the Town of Epsom raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$3,552,329. Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$3,531,446 which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Town of Epsom or by law, or the governing body may hold one special meeting in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.  The operating budget is estimated to have a tax rate of \$3.83, .12 cents less than the 2020 Tax rate. The default				
budget is estimated to have a tax rate of \$3.79, .16 cents less than the 2020 Tax rate.

<b>ARTICLE 16:</b> By petition of 25 or more eligible voters of the town of Epsom to see if the town will vote to urge that the New Hampshire General Court, which is obligated to redraw the maps of political districts within the state following the federal census, will ensure fair and effective representation of New Hampshire voters without gerrymandering.	
Additionally, these voters ask the town of Epsom to urge the NH General Court to carry out the redistricting in a fair and transparent way through public meetings, not to favor a particular political party, to include communities of interest, and to minimize multi-seat districts.  Furthermore, as the New Hampshire State Constitution, Part 2, Article 11 allows towns of sufficient population (>3,300) to have their own state representatives, not shared with other towns, for the town of Epsom to petition the NH General Court for its own exclusive seat(s) in the NH House of Representatives, ensuring that State Representatives property represent the town's interests.
