2	Significant	Human Injury: ♦ Significant injuries or illnesses result in no permanent disability. Essential Services/Infrastructure: ♦ Shutdown for up to 2 weeks.
		Property or Economic Damage: ♦ 10% to 25%.
3	Critical	Human Injury: Significant injuries or illnesses result in permanent disability. Essential Services/Infrastructure: Complete shutdown for at least 2 weeks. Property or Economic Damage: 525% to 50%.
4	Catastrophic	Human Injury: Death or multiple deaths. Essential Services/Infrastructure: Complete shutdown for 30 days or more. Property or Economic Damage: Greater than 50%.
